PEEPING INTO THE PAST from the Dungog Chronicle 22nd November, 1907

A meeting of residents took place here on Friday last for the purpose of discussing with Mr School Inspector Hunt the advisability of transferring the school to the opposite side of the river, and of erecting a new school. It was shown that two thirds of the children enrolled lived on the side opposite to the school, while the steady increase of enrolment in the future would soon render the present building too

small. A suitable site for a new school was selected in a position commanding a fine view of the Karuah and Port Stephens.

IT is hereby notified, for general information, in accordance with the provisions of the 34th section of the Public Instruction Act of 1880, that it is proposed to establish Public Schools at—

CRIEPTON,
MUNGAY CREEK,
UPPER POCKET,
WARRI,

in lieu of Provisional Schools; and

ALICETON

in lieu of Half-time School.

The name of the school, previously "Aliceton", was recently changed to Karuah. This brings it into line with the attempt made by the Progress Association to fasten the name of "Karuah" upon this locality. But old names die hard and the name Sawyer's Point, or familiarly "The Point", will long linger among old hands as a link with the past.

Did you Know?

The first church in Port Stephens area was erected by Sir Edward Parry, for the Australian Agriculture Co. at Carrington. This was the small stone church of St Andrew's. It was beautifully built with local stone, by convict labour. The inside fittings were all made from local cedar, which in the 1800s grew in abundance around Carrington and Karuah.

Services were still being held in St Andrew's until well into the 1900s. Mr Longworth, of Karuah, would regularly take boatloads of people to attend the Sunday Services.

Sadly, the church ceased operating in the 1940s and the pews and beautiful fittings were removed so that the building could be turned into a Youth Hostel. In later years it was sold and is now in private hands.

When the church was first built in 1847, it was called the **Church of the Holy Spirit**. It was closed in 1862 for some years and in 1888 it was completely restored by **Hon R.H.D. White** and rededicated as St Andrews.

Mr White was the owner of nearby Tahlee House. The original cemetery stills exists on a tract of land between Tahlee House and the Church with many historical graves within it. *Gwen Neil*

Windows 11 April Update KB5055523 Breaks Windows Hello

Windows Hello is the feature that lets you log into your device by using a pin number, face recognition or finger print scanner.

I generally don't recommend logging into a Microsoft account. However, if you have done so and used one of the above listed methods to access your device, you may receive a message saying the feature is no longer valid. To resolve this, you'll need to connect to the internet, sign in with your Microsoft email and password, and then recreate your PIN or set up other sign-in options to regain access to your computer.

So always write down your Microsoft password you will eventually be asked for it, even if you use a pin number or biometric login method.

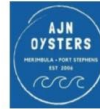

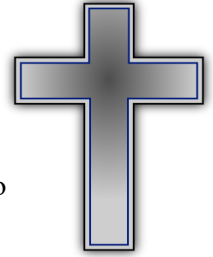
