## ENJOYABLE HISTORY CRUISE *by Cliff and Gabriela Johnson*

On a perfect day, 12<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 the ferry 'Tea Gardens' departed its home wharf about 10am, cruising along in a gentle breeze. This sturdy vessel, 82 years of age was our transport for this 'history cruise'. Previously this ferry had carried passengers along a number of waterways in NSW. John 'Stinker' Clarke was our host narrator on this trip, pointing out and providing historic information, relating to each area as we progressed along. His talks were very informative and entertaining.

After departing we firstly passed under the 'Singing Bridge', then the friendly staff handed out china plates for delicious finger foods. The food selection was beautiful and in abundance. Tea and coffee were also served in real mugs. The cruise headed down the Myall River passing many oyster farms, then on the left the former site of a very large steam driven sawmill and adjoining slipway, that was capable of dry docking extremely large 'droghers' used on the river for conveying timbers for use at the mill. Many water birds and recreation fishing boats could be seen, as the waves splashed on the bow of the ferry. Oyster farms were on both sides of the river extending all the way to and into Port Stephens. In places old farms have disappeared under the ever-shifting sands near the mouth of the river.



The southern shore of Port Stephens from Shoal Bay to Soldiers Point came into view as we entered the huge Port. Some distance into the deeper water the 'skipper' turned towards the west, bringing Middle Island into view. This meant the passengers could see the shore of Pindimar to their right-hand side. A huge shark and fish processing factory was established there in the early 1900's, because of the incredible number of species in the waterways. Unfortunately, the effectiveness of shark fishing diminished the numbers. After a few years the venture collapsed, due to over kill resulting in limited supply of stock available to the public.

The journey continued between Soldiers Point and Middle Island, entering the western section of the Port. We continued westward towards Karuah following the deepest channel, then passing Tahlee turned back to follow the northern shore towards Middle Island. Next, we passed Tahlee and Carrington, both have historic pasts being with in a one-million-acre grant of land to the Australian Agriculture Company, which had its original headquarters there, with the land extending beyond Taree. A historic church is at Carrington being the first convict built stone structure in Port Stephens in 1838; the lime used in the mortar for the building was made from oyster shells burnt in kilns nearby.

Next, we entered North Arm Cove, one of the largest coves of the Port, followed by the smaller Fame Cove, being the deepest harbour in Port Stephens. Then between Middle Island and the foreshore again into the eastern part of the Port where Pindimar became into view. A little further the mouth of Myall River again was near as we turned into its shallower water where a mother dolphin and her 60 centre metres long calf entered the pressure water wave caused by the bow of the ferry. This excited all on board as they leaned over the bow rail to watch the dolphins swim close to the hull and come to the surface a number of times. Our journey was nearly over when the Singing Bridge came into view, after almost three and a half hours. The skipper and crew guided the vessel gently into the wharf after a most pleasant and enjoyable cruise.
